Award for Excellence

All entries are eligible for this award. The winning entry is not eligible for any other award.

Conditions of entry

- ARTWORKS: Entries must be the *unaided, original, signed* work of the artist and have been *painted in the last 12 months*. The exhibitor accepts sole responsibility for ensuring that works exhibited do not infringe any Copyright Laws.
- LABELLING: Each entry must be identified on the back. Labels supplied.
- FRAMING: No metal frames, screw eyes or metal projections. 'D' clips/rings and staples must be taped over. Soft cord and plastic-coated wire accepted.
- UNFRAMED CANVASES: Unframed stretched canvases-deep-edged MUST HAVE staples at back and CLEAN and TIDY SIDES.
- NOT ACCEPTED: Workshop paintings, wet paintings, paintings marked 'not for sale'/NFS.
- OVERSIZED ARTWORKS: maximum 6 m (20 ft.) perimeter & maximum 2 entries in sections 1, 2, 5, 6 or 7.
- JUDGING: All conforming entries will be viewed by the Judge whose decision is final.
- STATEMENT BY SUPPLIER/ABN: Artists must provide either a Statement by Supplier form or their ABN. Statement by Supplier form is available from Australian Taxation Office and SGAS websites.
- ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per painting (non-refundable). See entry form for payment options.
- LIMIT: Limit of seven paintings per member.
- COMMISSION: 25% will be retained by St George Art Society Inc. on all artworks sold during the exhibition.
