"What a treat it was to watch Yvonne Langshaw paint. (I've always been an admirer of her work) She was totally

immersed in what she was doing, starting off with scribbly pencil lines on watercolour paper then painting with acrylics, applying the

paint vigorously, scumbling and pushing the paint around, using beautiful gestural lines then working, backing back, layer by layer. As she painted, areas disappeared and were reworked until she reached some point at which she was satisfied. I think we were all spellbound."

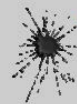
