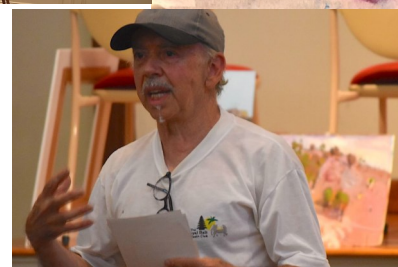
October Demonstration by Joe Bezzina on October 15th 2020

Joe described the Julie’s artwork **“Agar Steps”** as **“a lovely variation of marks and patterns to make a very successful picture”**.

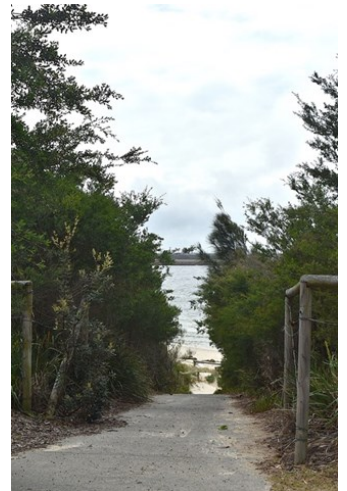
Plein Air

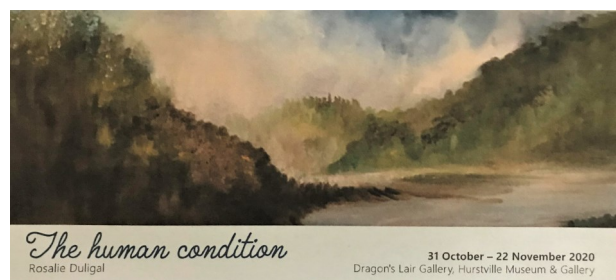

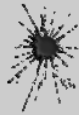

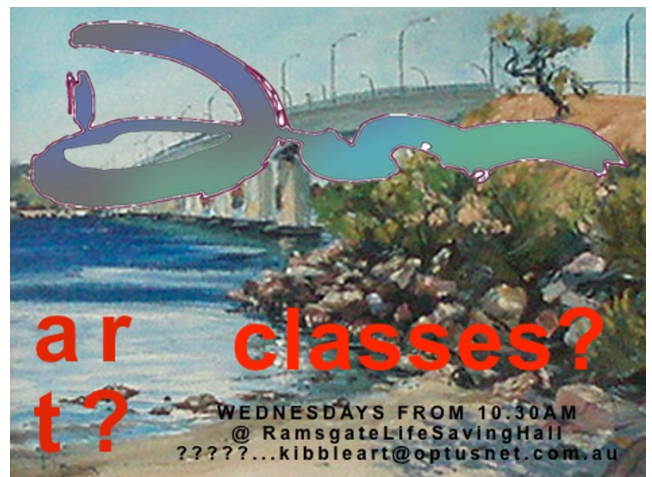
