Greetings SGAS Members,

It was great to see so many of our members attend the March Critique / Artwork selection for the Parliament House exhibition. This is the first of two such Critique/Selection nights, the next one being on April 7th 6:30 p.m. at the Kogarah School of Arts. The guest artist for April will be Brian Dickinson, who also runs our monthly Watercolour class. Brian will be the judge for the second selection night and will also do the Demonstration on April 21st.

We had over seventy artworks for the first Critique/Selection night, which was very pleasing, but it did provide a few challenges logistically. Jack Wu was obviously not able to spend as much time as he normally would on the critique of each artwork, but we did get through them all and it enabled everyone to see all the paintings. Thirty artworks were shortlisted, and a similar number will be selected at the April Critique. From the shortlisted artworks, approx. fifty will be selected for the exhibition.

The April Critique gives everyone a chance to submit an artwork for selection. If you were unable to attend the March Critique please bring up to three artworks along on April 7th. If you missed out on selection in March, you are welcome to bring the same or different artworks along to the April Critique.
