PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE - SEPTEMBER 2023

Greetings Members,

We had a great roll up of 22 people for August's demonstration by Sally Ryan and I am sure from the reactions and comments that everyone felt that they had witnessed something very special. Sally did a wonderful portrait in oils of Kathy Curtiss, who sat very still under hot lights for 90 minutes and the result was magnificent. Sally then went on to show her meticulous prep work for her commissioned painting of St. Joseph which now resides in St. Mary's cathedral. As if that wasn't enough, we then heard all about Sally's portrait of Claudia Chan Shaw, a finalist in this year's Archibald prize.

We are now in full swing organising not one, but *two SGAS exhibitions for November*. Our traditional Annual Art Show will be held from 3^{rd} *to* 5^{th} *November with* the official opening on Saturday night 4^{th} November. The Annual Art Show is for our members and is an opportunity for everyone to exhibit the artwork you have created over the past 12 months. It is a prestige event, which will have an official opening with invited guests, refreshments, and awards in the usual categories (plus a few new categories). The entry form and Terms and Conditions are currently being developed and should be with you soon.

The second exhibition will be at *Tempe House* under the banner "ArtReach – reaching others through art" and will follow hot on the heels of the Annual Art Show, running from *Saturday 11th to Sunday 19th November*. This exhibition will provide members with more flexibility to exhibit current and older works. We hope to reach a much wider audience than is possible at Kogarah School of Arts which hopefully will result in more sales.

The committee encourages you to enter both exhibitions. I will be co-ordinating the *Annual Art Show* and Jani Nanavati will co-ordinate the *Tempe House exhibition*. These two exhibitions can only succeed with your support. We will be calling on all our members to help with the preparation and running of these events. More details will follow about how and when you can assist.

For both exhibitions we will be calling for strong, fit bodies who can help to move the display screens and climb ladders to hang artworks. It is getting a bit much for the "old" crew. If you too are in that category, please ask the younger members of your family and friends if they can assist

Demonstration –Thursday 17th August



Sally spoke of her incredible journey to paint her commission hanging in St Mary's Cathedral Sydney, what a story of her artistic expertise and professionalism.

Sally is a classic portrait artist in the style of Rembrandt. She prefers to paint from life. Her palette is non-variable, based on red, yellow, blue considering chroma and tonal values. Sally paints in layers set up from base to vibrant.

Critique Thursday September 7th ... Dario Falzon

Currently lives and works in Sydney, Australia.

I consider myself a traditional realist painter. I'm inspired by finding the beauty in subtle, intimate scenes all around me. I work with oil paint because I find it the most versatile and suitable medium. My brushes and knives allow me a multitude of ways to describe and indicate an impression of my subject.

Primarily working en plein air, I capture impressions of the landscape around me. In working from life I'm constantly challenged by the passage of time but I feel that this is what gives my artwork its own unique voice. My paintings are a product of direct observation and experience of the landscape.

I may pass what appears to be a mundane scene everyday but for a small window of time, when the light is right, it transforms into something extraordinary, and that's what I'm always looking for and trying to capture.




