Watercolour workshop with Randy Hale

I was going to Europe for a family event so decided to take advantage of my time away and look for a good watercolour workshop. I'd been painting with watercolour since lockdown but mostly at my desk and rarely in plein-air. The course I decided on was led by American watercolour artist, Randy Hale, who is a master at plein-air painting and a wonderful instructor.

Coordinated by the art tour company, 'French Escapades', it was a week-long course held in a hidden gem of a fishing village on Spain's Costa Brava. Starting at 9 am, we painted every morning and every afternoon from 2 pm, apart from one afternoon when we were taken to the town of Figueres to see the museum of Salvador Dali. Tour





leaders from 'French Escapades' made sure all our needs were met, whether that was finding a folding chair to sit on or organising lunch at one of the town's many restaurants. The variety of settings where we got to paint was wonderful — picturesque coastlines, a botanic garden and a day in the medieval village of Pals.

I'm admirer of Randy's loose brushwork and his ability to work with the medium, letting the pigments flow effortlessly across whatever landscape he was painting. He gave numerous informative demonstrations, yet we were not there to copy his compositions but find our own from the beautiful scenery around us. So, once we had the composition, it was time to sketch, then paint and hopefully complete a painting before the shadows dramatically moved. Quite a challenge. What I gained from the week's intensive is more confidence with the medium, and how to bring out the light in a subject by focusing on the


contrasting darks. It was a very rewarding time for my watercolour education and a great way to explore this part of Spain.






